TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND NO PARKING AND NO WAITING
ALONG 3/206 RYEFORD ROAD SOUTH & ST GEORGES AVENUE KING'S
STANLEY PARISH AND THE STANLEYS WARD STROUD DISTRICT
ORDER 2017

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for 3/206 Ryeford Road South & St Georges Avenue ("the Road") is satisfied that use of part of the said Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road from the junction with Brockey Road to the junction with A419 Ebley Bypass, a total distance of approximately 620 metres
2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order
3. There will be no parking and no waiting throughout the duration of the works
4. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road
5. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road
6. The Road falls in the King's Stanley Parish and The Stanleys Ward in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire
7. This Order shall come into operation on the 19th June 2017 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months
8. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council, Temporary Road Closure and No Parking and No Waiting along 3/206 Ryeford Road South & St Georges Avenue, King's Stanley Parish and The Stanleys Ward, Stroud District Order 2017"
