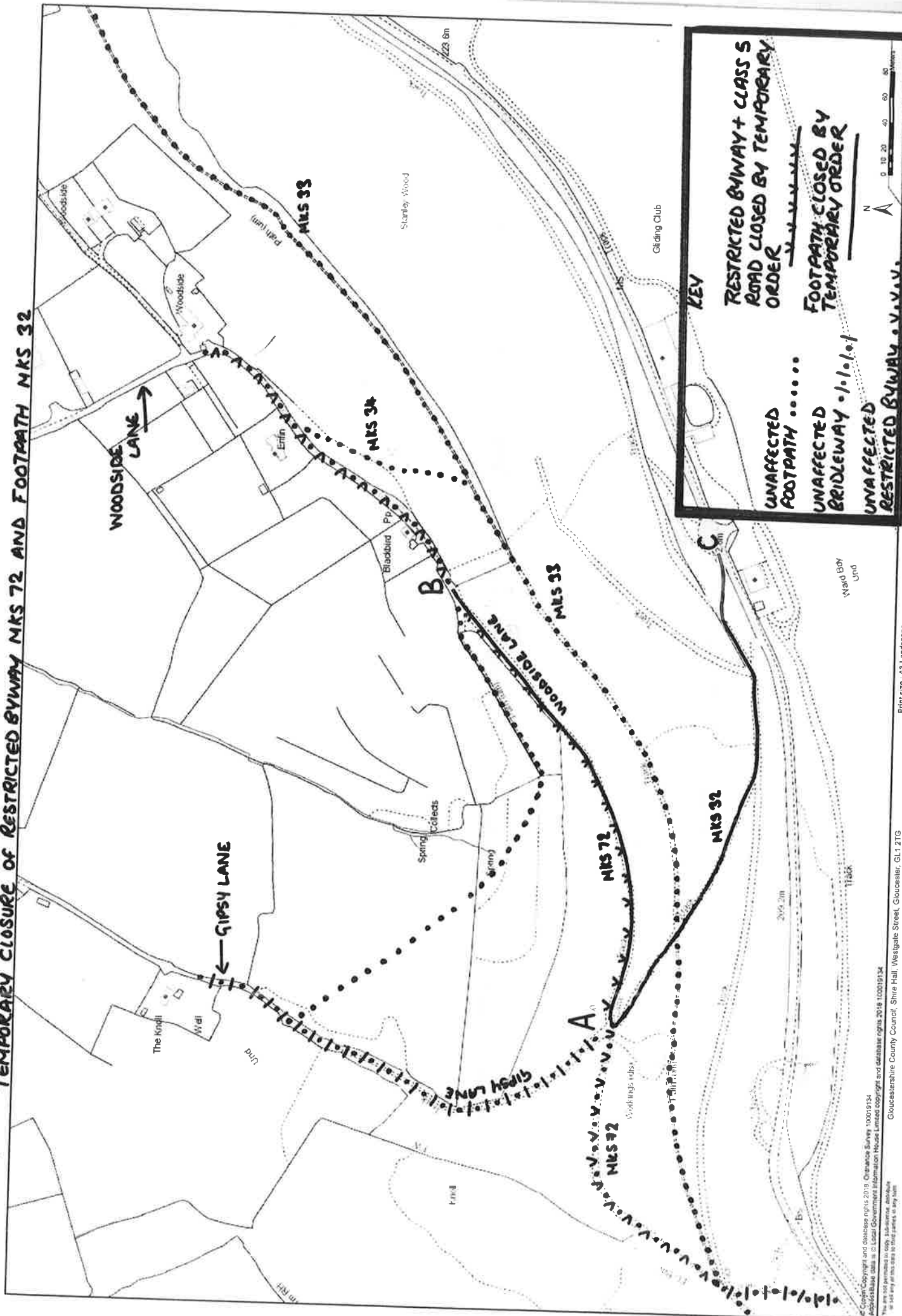


TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RESTRICTED BYWAY MKS 72 AND FOOTPATH MKS 32

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS MKS 72/MKS 32 STONEHOUSE TOWN, STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intend to make an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of:

- 1) Public Footpath MKS 72 which is also road number 51161 known as 'Woodside Lane' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SO 8015/0194 at its junction with Public Footpath MKS 32 south of The Knoll and continuing in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 385 metres to a point south-west of Blackbird Cottage OSGR SO 8082/0528 and shown on the site map by a bold solid black line with 'v's marked A to B.
- 2) Public Footpath MKS 32 from its junction with Restricted Byway MKS 72 at OSGR SO 8015/0194 south of 'The Knoll' and continuing in a generally south-easterly then easterly direction for approximately 420 metres to OSGR SO 8052/0187 west of the Gliding Club on road number B4066 and shown on the site map by a bold solid black line marked A to C..

The closure is necessary to replace a number of water pipes.

The Order will come into force on the 30th March 2018 and it is anticipated that the public rights of way will close on that day until 30th April 2018. However, if the works are not completed on this date, it may be necessary to make an order for a further five months. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.

The alternative route is via Woodside Lane, Marsh Lane, Church Road and Gipsy Lane.
